

A DALES HIGH WAY - TEMPORARY DIVERSION AT GLOVERSHAW BECK



Due to flooding following Storm Ciara, part of a recently restored revetment on the bank of Grovershaw Beck has washed away.

Bradford Council have issued a temporary closure notice for this section until repairs can be made.

We suggest therefore an alternative route to this short section.

From the start at Saltaire follow the route up through Trench Woods and onto Shipley Glen. Continue on until you reach the Dales High Way Fingerpost.

Here you can **EITHER** take the Optional high-level route via Hope Hill (as shown in the guidebooks), **OR** instead of continuing straight on, move right and follow the road (Glen Road) as it curves NE and rises. Take care with some fast moving traffic. There are parallel paths on the left but they can be very muddy at this time.

Once you reach the road junction with Bingley Road, cross with care, bearing left to a gate and a signed footpath. Follow this northward, keeping a wall on your left, to rejoin the main route at a gate onto the horse training track.
